



YEAR 7 CATCH UP REPORT 2016-17

Context

2016 SATs Results

37 children not ARE in Maths in SATs, 27 in Reading, 29 in SPaG, 22 in writing

Please note that approximately 20% of the Y6 cohort leave to go to the two-tier system in Gloucestershire or Warwickshire.

We have chosen 1 to 1/small group interventions as a moderate impact, relatively low-cost intervention which adds approximately +5 months according to the Education Endowment Foundation Toolkit for Learning.

Summary of impact:

For maths - 2/37 (5%) were exceeding expectations (ie caught up and overtaken) by the end of Year 7; 11/37 (30%) were reaching expectations by the end of Year 7 (ie had caught up with peers/at ARE for Y7); 24/37 (ie 65%) were still behind expectations at the end of Year 7. However, of these 18 (ie 67%) had scaled scores of 95 or below, and 58% had scaled scores of 90 or below.

For reading - 1/27 (4%) was exceeding by the end of Year 7; 18/27 (67%) were reaching expectations; and 8/27 (30%) were still behind. Of these, 3 (38%) had scaled scores of 90 or below, and there are three missing marks.

For writing - 10/22 (45%) were reaching expectations by the end of year 7; with 12/22 (55%) still behind.

SPaG is not assessed separately in Year 7.

Next steps:

Pupils still operating below ARE will have additional support in English and Maths in Y8.
