Eco Day and Worcester University Lakeside Activity Day

On **Wednesday 13th July 2022**, your child will be taking part in an Eco Day, on site. They need to arrive at normal time and usual breaks and food service will be available. Your child should come in old non-uniform and be prepared for getting muddy! We will be outside for all of the day so please ensure sure your child packs waterproofs or hat and sun cream, depending on the UK weather! It would also be helpful if your child could bring a container, such as an old welly, teapot, planter to plant outdoor plants in - the more unusual the better!

On **Thursday 14th July 2022**, your child will be taking part in the Worcester University Lakeside Activity Day.

Students, who have signed up, will take part in 3 activities at Worcester University, Lakeside, Holt Heat, Worcs. Two activities will be land based and one will be water based. The activities will be led by qualified instructors and there will be a member of Blackminster staff with each group.

We will be travelling by coach from Blackminster at approx. 8:30am and expect to return for the end of the school day at 3:30pm. Your child will need to be collected from school, as we will not be back in time for the buses.

Students will need to come dressed in suitable sportswear for the day. They will also need swimwear, sports clothes and footwear suitable for water activities (clothing and footwear will get wet, and not wellies) and a towel. If pupils have their own wetsuit/water shoes they can bring these if they wish.

Please consider the possible changeable weather and also pack spare warm clothes, as well as sun cream and a sun hat as applicable. Students will also need a **packed lunch and lots of drink**. All other equipment, including a life jacket will be provided by the centre.

Equipment check list:
